

Our universal responsibility



dimension. Because of this, ethical discipline, wholesome conduct and careful discernment are crucial ingredients for a meaningful, happy life. Let us now consider this proposition in relation to the wider community. In the past, families and small communities could exist more or less independently of one another. If they took into account their neighbour's wellbeing, so much the better. Yet they could survive quite well without this kind of perspective. This is no longer the case. Today's reality is so complex and, so clearly interconnected on the material level that a different outlook is needed. Modern economics is a case in point. A stock market crash on one side of the globe can have a direct effect on the economies of countries on the other. Similarly, our technological achievements are now such that our activities have an unambiguous effect on the natural environment. And the very size of our population means that we cannot afford to ignore others' interests any longer. Indeed, we find that these are often so intertwined that serving our own interests benefits others, even though this may not be our explicit intention. For example, where two families share a single water source, ensuring that it is not polluted benefits both.

Given today's reality, it is therefore essential to cultivate a sense of what I call universal responsibility. This may not be an exact translation of the Tibetan term I have in mind, *chi-sem*, which means literally universal (chi) consciousness (sem). Although the notion of responsibility is implied rather than explicit in Tibetan, it is definitely there. When I say that on the basis of concern for others' well-being we can, and should, develop a sense of universal responsibility, I do not, however, mean to suggest that each

individual has a direct responsibility for the existence of, for example, wars and famines in different parts of the world. It is true that in Buddhist practice we constantly remind ourselves of our duty to serve all sentient beings in every universe. Similarly, the theist recognises that devotion to God includes devotion to the welfare of all creatures. But clearly certain things, such as the poverty of a single village ten thousand miles away, are completely beyond the scope of the individual. What is entailed therefore is not an admission of quilt, but a re-orientation of our heart and mind away from self and towards others. To develop a sense of universal responsibility - of the universal dimension of our every act and of the equal right of all others to happiness and not to suffer - is to develop an attitude of mind whereby, if we see an opportunity to benefit others, then we will take it in preference to merely looking after our own narrow interests. And although we care about what is beyond our scope, we accept it as part of nature and concern ourselves with doing what we can.

An important benefit of developing such a sense of universal responsibility is that it helps us become sensitive to all others – not just those closest to us. We come to see the need to care especially for those members of the human family who suffer most. We recognise the need to avoid causing divisiveness amongst our fellow human beings. And we become aware of the overwhelming importance of contentment.

When we neglect others' well-being and ignore the universal dimension of our actions, it is inevitable we will come to see our interests as separate from theirs. We will overlook the fundamental oneness of the human family...

In order to overcome our tendency to ignore others' needs and rights, we must continually remind ourselves of what is obvious: that basically we are all the same... Just as I want to be happy and to avoid suffering, so do they. On the basis of this recognition, I will quite naturally feel well disposed towards them. And concern for their well-being will arise almost by itself.

A necessary change

Just as we have a responsibility to look after the needs of others, we also benefit our 'selves' from acting in this way. Almost every religion, Hinduism, Taoism, Judaism, Sikhism, Christianity etc. mentions within its writings, a moral law known as the Golden Rule, which basically says: 'Do unto others, as you would have them do to you'.

This is interpreted by the Buddhist doctrine of Karma to indicate what should be a universal understanding, that what you do to others in your life has a direct effect on what happens to you. Sometimes this can be implicit, for example, if you shout at someone or hit someone there is a strong chance of you being shouted at or hit back. On another level, you might be able to see that things which have happened to you could have been caused by earlier events where the causal link is not so evident. There have been many events in my recent life, where I see that what is happening to me is exactly what I have done to someone else in the past. There are other things which cannot be so easily correlated and some people say that karma is carried from past lives.

Scientists in the West have come up with Quantum Physics and String theory as their interpretation of the Universe which suggests that particles of energy can be both separate and through entanglement operate together. This inter-connectedness of energy, earlier Buddhist thought explained as the Inter-dependent nature of reality.

Applying these rules to the current economic and political systems we live with, it would seem clear that those who invade and try to subjugate another people so as to control their oil supply are creating future servitude for themselves. The banking families who through the Federal Reserve fund those wars and operate the macro financial system to protect their own fortunes are creating an unfortunate future for themselves. The Chinese industrialists polluting rivers and affecting air quality are creating bad health for themselves. Similarly, those Chinese bureaucrats who repress the Tibetan people are going to suffer mental and physical torture. Revolve's heart goes out to the Tibetan Buddhists carrying out selfimmolation to protest Chinese attempts to stop them practising their beliefs.

Baba Ram Dass: his story and the path to enlightenment



Throughout life we all try and satisfy the demands of our egos — often simply reacting to conditioned messages about what we should do or aim for — without thinking what we are doing and why we are here. Baba Ram Dass, who in the Sixties was better known as Dr Richard Albert was one such man, until he questioned exactly what he was doing and decided to follow a spiritual life.


A celebrated Harvard University Professor of Psychology, his mind was 'opened up' when alongside Timothy Leary they started the Psilocybin project in 1961. Psilocybin, the chemical and hallucinogenic consituent of what are commonly known as 'Magic Mushrooms', enabled him and others to break free of what Leary called game play, our conditioned reactions to society's demands on us — which are fashioned by a control structure incorporating religion, finance and education.

Richard Albert and Leary were donated use of a large house called Millbrook where they continued their experiments, this time with LSD, correlating the states of mind they experienced to Tibetan Buddhist thought with the help of Ralph Metzner. Their use of LSD on the East coast of America often incorporated Yoga and Meditation, but occasionally Richard Albert and others would delve further taking 400 micrograms of LSD every day for three weeks. Richard Albert also visited the West Coast, experiencing the more hedonistic use of LSD with the Grateful Dead, Ken Kesey and the Merry Pranksters.

And then all that began to come to an end when, like many others, in 1967 he went to India.

It took a while, as it does for all of us following the path to a deeper understanding of life and ourselves, but eventually he met a man he calls his guru, Maharji-Ji also known as Neem Karoli Baba who taught, maybe just helped him to live a spiritual life. Helped, because Ram Dass came to realise that you can be your own guru, you and the guru share the same consciousness – are one and the same.

From that time onwards, he was given the name by Maharji-Ji of Baba Ram Dass which means servant of God and which he now used.



All of this progress is detailed in a book that Ram Dass wrote called: 'Be Here Now. It is an amazing book useful for anyone to go deeper into the mysteries of mind and / or follow spiritual practice, known in Hindu as Sadhana. In the third part of the book, 'The Cookbook for a sacred life.' Ram Dass details the practices that he was advised to follow with regard to yoga, diet (Vegetarian) and paying attention to Consciousness. The latter, a process as many of you hopefully know, where you become aware of your thoughts and through practising meditation, still the mind. Although initially it isn't easy, practice makes perfect as everyone knows, and through meditating we all are able to learn better how to control our thoughts, become less agitated, deal with stress better and eventually open up to our higher consciousness.

"The journey of a thousand miles begins with one step," wrote Lao Tzu, the founder of Taoism.

Through following this process, Ram Dass realised that although his advancement along the path of life to more spiritual practice had been majorly helped with LSD it was not the end of the path.

Some aspects aren't for sure benefical. It depends on the dose, but LSD

taken within a social setting ('set' and 'setting' were and are always the most important aspects to consider when taking LSD) can make one feel anxiety and that in turn can mean that the mind starts to run very fast with many thoughts which can become confusing and even overwhelming. (Read the Barefoot Doctor's advice on the 'Revolve' website about pressure points if you ever have a problem with this.)

Having followed the psychedelic route himself, Ram Dass can of course see many benefits to starting along the path to enlightenment using psychedelics.

He writes: "For a person deeply attached to any finite reality which he takes to be absolute, the psychedelics can, under proper conditions, help him to break out of the imprisoning model created by his own mind."

Many believe that LSD was necessary to take root in Western society, because after all it was the Western mindset which had used the Atomic bomb and just fought two World Wars killing many millions.

Another teacher, Hari Dass Baba percepitively writes: "LSD is like Christ in America which is awakening the young folk... America is most materialistic country, therefore God has shown his avatar in a form of LSD (a material). They wanted a material for approaching God and they got it in the form of LSD."

While the drug strengthens users' faith in the possibility of enlightenment by providing them with a glimpse of it, especially if used within a programmed session, the main problem as Ram Dass realised was that as many times as you went up, you had to come back down.

As he says: "The goal of the path is to BE high, not GET high."

Following a spiritual practice takes you onward and upward towards higher chakra (energy centres) so you can be high all the time. Using psychedelics is a fast method but not without risks.

As Baba Ram Dass writes: "There are many paths which lead towards enlight-enrment. Some of these paths lead all the way, while others take a pilgrim only a little way. Some paths are steep and dangerous; others slow and gentle."

Indian scholars and Yogis have known about the existence of different chakras, energy centres, or bundles of nerve fibres which exist at various points along the spine going from the Root chakra, in between the anus and the genitals, to the Sacral (sex) chakra around the position of the genitals and then the Solar Plexus chakra above the navel at the point just below where the ribs start.

These are shown on the painting by Alex Grey used on the front cover.

As human beings, we advance from preoccupation with basic survival as a child when we are dominated by root chakra energy, to the Sacral chakra around the ages of puberty and our emerging sexuality, to establishing ourselves in the world when we have to use our 'power,' present within the Solar Plexus as any martial artist will know.

The next chakra above that is the Heart chakra. Now that we have the ability as a race to use technology to benefit our lives, then survival for most people shouldn't be such a struggle. For those less fortunate, then if we collectively advance to the state of heart energy (or heart-based consciousness: 'the Shift' - see last Summer's 'Revolve') our compassion as a collection of individuals will have grown to the level where we can help poorer countries more effectively. Already of course many people - we all are naturally compassionate - give to charity providing water and food for those less fortunate in other parts of the world.

It seems, however, as if the banking families and nobility, those at the top of the pyramid don't currently want us to progress collectively to the level of people occupied with heart-based energy and consciousness and this is what most of us need to deal with.

As Ram Dass indicates many people are stuck at the level of first, second and third chakra dominated people. As he writes:

"In our Western culture there has been such an investment in the models of man associated with the second and third chakra (sex and power) that we have developed strong and deeply-held habits of perceiving the inner and outer universe in these terms. Though we may realise intellectually that the spiritual journey requires the transformation of energy from these preoccupations to higher centres, we find it difficult to override these strong habits which seem to be reinforced by the vibration of the culture in which we live."

"Thus it seems "normal" to have certain ego needs with regard to sex and power. It is difficult for us to comprehend that what is normal for a secondchakra preoccupied person is hardly normal for a fourth-chakra person."

We are often reminded of sex by music videos, billboards and advertising

etc. which concentrate on sexual imagery. Advertisers, scriptwriters, shoddy promoters know that using sex sells.

Also does monogamy work? Ram Dass believes that you should practice celibacy or tantra to advance spiritually while having a sex life.

"You can avoid arousing these energies and simultaneously work from within to transmute these latent forces into spiritual energy. This requires sexual continence and is called brahmacharya (celibacy). The alternative is to continue to arouse the second chakra energies and to attempt to direct these now manifest energies into spiritual realms. This technique is known as sexual tantra."

Tantra is a practice which requires the man and woman to work together as an act of purification to become ONE and share karma. To transmute lust and turn it into love. As Ram Dass writes: "You are both man and you are both woman... and there is an act in which two bodies are involved, but the act (like two hands clapping) is a unity experienced by a single consciousness."

With regards the Solar Plexus chakra, then naked 'Power' seems to be the order of the day. Occupy protestors demonstrating peacefully or those in Syria have been forced with shows of power to move against their will and of course, the UK and US invaded two Islamic countries to grab their oil, protect pipelines or simply force regime

Using power to reinforce ego simply establishes more karma for you as an individual or country to deal with later in life, unless it is used for something positive and the collective good.

Ouspenksy writes 'In search of the

miraculous': "If a man gives way to his desires, or panders to them, there will be no inner struggle in him, no 'friction' no fire. But if, for the sake of attaining a definite aim, he struggles with the desires that hinder him he will then create a fire will gradually transform his inner world into a single whole."

For some it can be an easy process and it is one that we all should embark on: directing our sexual energy and power to transformation.

Yoga and meditation, mantra chanting and energy from the lower centres, the first three chakras, to help produce a mind which resonates permanently in the fourth to seventh chakras. Unifying the demands of the lower chakras means our lives become more at ease and so we develop spiritually into complete unified human beings.

Ram Dass writes: "The Bible is not a metaphor, it's a story made up to teach us how to be moral beings. It's a straight message of how it is when a man lives in the spirit, and the spirit is right inside. The way to get into the spirit is not a lot of hocus-pocus. It's a very simple, methodical, mechanical set of steps but they're only available to him who can hear."

Live your life with attention, follow the fourth noble truth of Buddhism which Ram Dass summarises as: "Get your life straight, do your work, do everything you've got to do. Watch your speech, watch your thought. Watch your calmness. Get your calm centre going. Live your life in such a way as to get yourself straight, to get free of attachment that just keeps sucking you in all the time."

Living a spiritual life, Baba Ram Dass with Larry Brilliant helped set up the Seva Foundation which has removed cataracts and restored eyesight to three million people in Asia and Africa. He also founded the Love Serve Remember Foundation.


His life has been an amazing passage to enlightenment and the book 'Be Here Now I would recommend everyone to read. As he suffered a stroke 15 years ago, this article is not in Baba Ram Dass' own words and not entirely about him, but I assume its focus is largely something he would support.

Alex Grey

Early on you worked as an Anatomist preparing cadavers for dissection. While this paved the way for the stripped-down bodies of your anatomical work, what moved you to show living bodies with the key addition of a spiritual dimension?



My intention was to make art about consciousness. I sought a job at a medical school morgue in order to study the container in which consciousness lives. After experiencing altered states where I saw the luminous bodies, I researched theories of psychic energy. I studied the works of Wilhelm Reich, George Crile, Harold Saxton Burr, Baron Von Reichenbach, the diagrams of the Theosophical Society, yogic chakras and nadis, acupuncture meridians and points, auras and all maps of the subtle body. No one was teaching this at the medical school where I worked. I interviewed psychics and faith healers to get their perspective on the appearance of subtle energies. Several mediums spoke of a kind of X-ray vision that help

them direct their healing energy.

How has entheogenic use stimulated and influenced your work as an artist? Do you feel blessed with the circumstances of your first acid trip?

Blessed, indeed. My first psychedelic experience occurred at a time when I was a committed existentialist on the brink of suicide. I asked a God I did not believe in to show me a sign and within one day I had had my first mystical experience and met Allyson, the Divine manifest in the flesh for me. Because I called to God, within 24 hours, I went from a nihilist to a mystic.

I cannot responsibly recommend psychedelics to everyone because, for some, often when used in a dangerous or unconsidered set and setting, the experience can cause a psychotic episode. For a spiritual experience to occur, substances must be considered sacraments and one should plan carefully. This can include quiet meditation and spiritual music in an undisturbed, safe environment in the presence of a С i а supportive friend or loved one. For many, psychedelics, which are neither toxic nor addictive, have been an opening to a spiritual life. For me, they opened a new realm of visionary worlds for my art.

What has been the effect on your work both stylistically and in terms of the subject-matter of your long and loving marriage to Allyson, another respected visionary artist?

Allyson and I have shared a studio since 1975 – 37 years. Our art is inevitably influenced by each other. Neither of us create without the input of


the other. CoSM, Chapel of Sacred Mirrors is our collaborative artwork, our 'social sculpture.' Our enduring love is a spiritual, creative path and the prime subject of much of my artwork.

Love is the glue that holds together the universe.



Robert Venosa and others have talked about the similarities between visionary artists and Shamans. How has this informed your choice of subject-matter? What message are you trying to convey to the viewer and how would you say your paintings represent a healing process for mankind?

In my first book, 'Sacred Mirrors', published in 1990, long before I had ever heard of Robert Venosa, Carlo McCormick put forward the comparison between my performance art and





visionary art and shamanism because the paintings and performances were ordeals based on visions. The shaman journeys to inner worlds to gain insight and make healing contact with entities or mediate problems for the benefit of a community. When we journey with entheogens we encounter spiritual beings or demonic forces and may transend these astral beings entirely and enter into a state of mystic union with the cosmic mind. The mystical experiments


ence is the most healing experience a person can have because it heals our breach with God, giving us a foundation of love and ethical orientation to good works in the world. My highest intention is to share mystical visionary experiences to further the spiritual lives of viewers.

I create art from inner visions but do not cons-ider myself a shaman. Becoming a shaman requires specialised knowledge in the practice of traditional rituals passed on from other shamans.

For me, art is a spiritual practice and my subject matter relates to expanded consciousness. The Sacred Mirrors and other paintings of ideal states of consciousness can be used as healing tools of self-reflection when that is the intention held by the viewer.


Have you added details to your work like our luminous body synchronistically having seen them or been influenced by the work of Dr Alberto Villoldo and others?

My work, created in 1980 became



associated with Alberto Villoldo's work 20 years later in a film for which he obtained rights to use my images. Images of the luminous body can be found in most sacred art. Halos and glowing saints are ubiquitously pictured throughout sacred art in most traditions since shamanic cave art. I have seen the subtle body while in altered states. The etheric layer can be seen by most people if they look for it.

My spiritual teachers have included





Ibn Arabi, Ken Wilber and our special teacher, Micky Singer, author of 'The Untethered Soul, a book I highly recommend. Namkhai Norbu has been my Tibetan Buddhist teacher along with His Holiness the Dalai Lama, Allyson and I attended the first talks by His Holiness in America, a five-day workshop on Mahayana Buddhism at Harvard School of Divinity in 1979. He is truly the highest representative of spirit on

Please explain how the artwork used for the cover 'Theologue' came about (shown in full overleaf) and what is depicted within the painting?

The painting 'Theologue' has an explanatory subtitle: 'The Union of Human and Divine Consciousness Weaving the Fabric of Space and Time in which the Self and Its Surroundings are Embedded.' We project our



perception of the material world from our mind. Surrounding the meditating figure is a ring of fire representing the energy and urgency that surrounds us, all that threatens our tranquillity when we quiet our minds in focused meditation. 'Theologue' is an image I envisioned on an LSD journey. With my eyes closed, seated in a meditating position, I could see the Himalayan Mountains appear and then recede on the horizon. All perception is projected from the mind's imagination.

There is often a network of interlocking eyes surrounding a figure or like a tunnel, could you explain why and what they are representative of

The eye is a symbol of awareness. We look into the eye to see if someone is listening, awake or alive. Many eyes



means expanded awareness. Infinite eyes - infinite consciousness. A tunnel symbolises the pathway of the soul or spirit. There are many people who have seen these archetypal visions, my art has been validating for them.

In more recent years you have created The Chapel of Sacred Mirrors in New York as a transformational Art gallery. Please describe what it is and how the works within it fit together?

The Chapel of Sacred Mirrors (CoSM) is a sanctuary built by artists for contemplation and creative spiritual renewal. CoSM's mission is to create a public exhibition of the Sacred Mirrors and outstanding works of mystical

From 2004 to 2009, the Chapel of



Sacred Mirrors operated a centre for visionary culture in Manhattan's gallery district. There were over 50 major works on view including the 21 Sacred Mirrors. Tens of thousands of people have visited over the years. Robert Venosa, Martina Hoffman and numerous other visionary artists were given solo exhibitions in our satellite space, MicroCoSM Gallery. Because it is CoSM's mission to build sacred architecture, the Manhattan space was always considered temporary and we continued to search for land to build a temple. In 2009, CoSM moved 65 miles north of Manhattan to a 40-acre retreat centre where we have been renovating existing buildings and preparing to build the Chapel. The current project is to transform an 1882 carriage house into Entheon Exhibition Hall where the Sacred Mirrors and the other well-loved paintings will again be on view.



In a world beleaguered by religious strife and escalating violence, teetering on the precipice of environmental collapse and nuclear terror, CoSM honours the pre-eminence of love, and the transformative wisdom potential of all humanity. The Chapel of Sacred Mirrors affirms universal spirituality, reverence for the web of life and the evolving miracle of our cosmos. Pointing to the integration of both scientific and spiritual truths, both outer and inner worlds, this artwork venerates earthly, visionary and transcendental realms. It is the mission of CoSM to awaken higher consciousness and conscience.

Art is our religion.

What effect do you hope it has on people who see it? And are donations still needed for its completion?


Entheon means a place to discover the God within. Entheon Exhibition Hall will hold that intention. CoSM is becoming a place of inner contemplation for pilgrims who may be inspired to embrace art as a spiritual path. CoSM is a recognised trans-denominational church and donations are essential to all spiritual institutions. If a spiritual centre offers comfort and community, members of that community maintain that centre with voluntary offerings. CoSM is also supported by selling uplifting products, offering heart-opening events, and through appearances and workshops held all over the world. Through this outreach, CoSM, a spiritual centre, is a globally-supported initiative.

The target date for the opening of the Chapel of Sacred Mirrors to be built on these temple grounds is 2020.

What do you hope 2012 leads to and what would you like to say to convince the members of society not aware of their importance, about the spiritual dimensions you have captured in your works and seen on your psychedelic voyages?

Our goal in 2012 is to build Entheon Exhibition Hall and to bring back on view the visionary paintings and sculpture that has become the context of our community.

Increasing levels of anxiety build regarding the state of humanities destruction of the life web. It is essential that we use every method we know to wake ourselves up and repair our relationship with nature. At CoSM, it is our intention to create a centre for visionary culture in a model of eco-awareness.

My name is Wai H. Tsang. I was involved in the London-based Psychedelic Trance scene in the 1990s

where I first encountered psychedelic drugs and in particular LSD. It was LSD or 'Acid' that gave me a whole new way of looking at things. I worked with the Psychedelic party promoter Fraser Clark and did a stint working with Bill Halsev/Cosmosis on his live shows. In 1998 and onwards I left the world of music and psychedelia. My life became focused on the goal that I'd set for myself in my late teens, to work out how the brain worked and to figure out how to create Artificial Intelligence. This quest to understand Brain and Mind was also complemented now by a burning desire to find a way to explain to the wider world that a person's true identity is God. There followed years of intense study. thinking, public speaking, working on my theories and getting my act together.

Fast forward to 2012, I've finished my Brain theory and it's ready for revealing this year. I think it's something very special and the feedback I've already received encourages me to believe so. Due to some special properties the theory will be quickly perceived as not just any old theory but as one that is final and definitive. A comprehensive and definitive Fractal Brain Theory that will initially revolutionise the worlds of Artificial Intelligence and Neuroscience, change the worlds of Technology and Science, then also the realms of commerce, economics and politics; eventually the world of Religion and Spirituality.


An interesting property of the theory is that it is able to show people that the Mystery of Consciousness and the Mystery of God are one and the same.

It shows that in the nature of the brain we may discern the nature of God and vice versa, it shows that the 'Sacred' is reflected in the functioning and fractal structure of our brains. So this theory is the key to reviving the Pagan Mysteries for the 21st-century and bringing Psychedelic truths into the mainstream.

Some technical details of the Fractal Brain Theory


roots (i.e. axons) and branches (i.e. dendrites), so it is with all brain structures at all levels and all scales of consideration. They all follow a similar branching pattern of organisation with roots flowing information into all the fractal nested structures of the brain; together with branching structures flowing information out from them. The theory shows how the brain has a nested Russian Doll structure, with these tree-

like structures nested within each other with the smallest russian dolls consisting of individual brain cells. So in this way the brain is fractal in structure.

But furthermore the brain is also fractal in process. In that all the processes happening at the level of the neuron are also happening at all the intermediate scales and components of the brain right up to the level of the whole brain and the level of introspection. So for example in the same way



that neurons will link up with one another, i.e. the axon branchings of one neuron will join up with the dendrite roots of another neuron, so too will the stereotypical modules called Cortical Column. made up of 100s of neurons, likewise link up with each other. These Columns which represent the atoms of our perceptions and actions come to form representations of the things we can sense with our eyes and ears etc. and all the things we can do using our muscles with our arms, legs and bodies. And then likewise these representations will link up to form our complex behaviours, skills and our memories. Together with this fractal process of linking up in the brain; there is also at all levels within the brain a process of competition. Neurons compete with one another for nerve growth factor which determines whether they survive or not. The connections between neurons, called synapses, compete with one another to determine how neurons link up. Cortical columns compete with one another to register our atoms of perception and atoms of action. Also entire perceptions compete with one another to register in our consciousness and whole actions will compete for expression. And furthermore we know in our introspection that ideas compete in our heads when we have to make decisions.

The above description is interesting and quite innovative, but what this Fractal Theory also does is to completely decompose the human brain, with all its myriad complexity, into a single unifying fractal structure which accounts for the entire brain. In the same way that neurons are like microscopic trees, what the theory shows is that our minds and contents of our brains are structured as a single allencompassing tree of knowledge, onto which is encoded all our thoughts, memories and ideas; our perceptual and behavioural categories, sub-categories and micro-categories, right down

to our atoms of perception and action. Furthermore the Fractal Brain Theory is able to reduce all this fractal detail and complexity into a single recursive atom and recursive computer algorithm; very much like the recursive atom called the fertilised egg and recursive process called cell division from which our bodies and brains emerge. This is called Seed Artificial Intelligence, the Holy Grail within the Holy Grail of Al. This result will stun the world. But there's more

This Fractal Brain Theory has the very special property that it completely extrapolates into the external world of Society, Life on Earth and the Evolution of the Universe; and vice versa the theory shows that the Cosmic process and that of the Planet completely interpolates into the process of the brain. That is, just as there is a fractal and nested Russian Doll process of linking up and competing in the brain, so too is this the case for society and the evolution of life on earth and so for the Universe. The idea that the Universe is a fractal is very ancient. For as it is written in ancient Hindu holy texts, the Upanishads, 'As is the human body, so is the cosmic body; as is the human mind so is the cosmic mind: as is the microcosm so is the macrocosm and as

is the atom so is the Universe." What the Fractal Brain Theory, that is to emerge in London 2012, will show clearly and explicitly is the true nature of the Universe. For it is in understanding the mind and brain that we understand the Cosmos. This derives from the ultimate truth that our true nature is God. That is the notion that the Christ within, Krishna within, Buddha within, Allah within etc. is really talking about Consciousness. Or that there is one all pervasive, undivided and indivisible Consciousness, which may be called God, and that we are it. So that when people experience themselves as being God or 'Being One with the Universe', then this is not illusory, it is the truth.

The Fractal Brain Theory will show that what historically has always been the unbelievable truth has today, at the end of the age, become the inescapable truth. And so the great 2012 awakening will be made possible when a compelling and convincing way is finally presented to explain to people that they are asleep in the first place. Therefore this is not just a scientific theory of the brain and technological marvel (i.e. the keys to the so called Technological Singularity) but also a significant Spiritual / Mystical Revelation.

Conclusion

Some people have predicted the emergence this year of something to do with Mind, Brain, Consciousness and/or Artificial Intelligence. Maybe this could be myself. The Fractal Brain theory will stun the world and allow its peoples to understand the mystery Consciousness, which is that there is undivided One and Indivisible Consciousness that may be called God, and that they are it. 2012 and beyond is going to be an eventful time and this theory will alter the course of things.

The Path of Meditation



s the story goes, a stranger in a small town asked an elderly local man how he could get to a certain city, some distance away. The local man thought

for a while, then said: "If I was going there. I wouldn't start from here."

That answer seems illogical. However, for many people, I think it's true, in the sense that you probably can't get to your spiritual home directly from where you are. You may first need to transform your life.

No, I don't mean that you need a new hairstyle, a weight-loss program, or a new career.

What you may need to change, to succeed in the spiritual journey, is not so much your habits as your self-image, or your worldview.

Perhaps this change can be done on an analytical or intellectual level, but I think that an active practice of meditation is essential for most people who want to find the meaning of life, and to

live that meaning.

However, to meditate in order to transform your spiritual nature may not be so easy if you don't also transform some of your basic lifestyle choices.

If you spend an hour a day mediating but 15 hours a day living 'the old way', your transformation may be very slow. Before I started meditating, I thought a lot about spirituality, but I was still living in an 'old way' that included a bit of drinking and quite a bit of eating meat and other unwholesome foods.

I also slept till any time of day, attended any sort of party or entertainment, and ingested some hallucinogenic substances. (One might argue that our normal life is a hallucination or illusion, but let's save that theme for another day.)

So with all this, I was getting nowhere, spiritually speaking.

When I took up meditation I started moving my mind toward spirituality, toward Cosmic Consciousness, toward spiritual bliss. However, I soon realised that it was hard to actively identify myself with Cosmic Consciousness if I was constantly dulling my mind with

mundane pleasures.

I couldn't get 'there' (Spiritual Bliss) from a 'here' that was leaving me fragmented. So I threw out a lot of the old way, the dull baggage, that was befogging my mind and I bought some new travel gear, including vegetarianism, yoga asanas, and chanting, among other things.

Thus I could support my regular meditation with new habits that were moving me toward a spiritual goal.

With my old habits I embraced a worldview that valued the rocky road of short-term pleasure over inner peace.

So, perhaps the old man was right. By starting with a 'here' of 'I want fun, right now', I couldn't go directly to a 'there' of Cosmic Consciousness. The train I needed to travel on couldn't carry all my old baggage. New habits were essential, if I were to reach my destination.

Yudhisthira

Ogi and Bugi are the names behind the Macedonian psytrance act Yudhisthira. 'Revolve' asked about the project and their local scene

How long have you been releasing music and who does what in the act? Our first release was in 2005. Usually I'm at the stove cooking the ingredients and Bugi adds the spices, but sometimes we swap. The best results come when we get the right temperature and the right spices.

You make really trippy morning-style forest music, what was it that got you writing in this style?

We grew up with lots of different music backgrounds. I was playing dub and a lot of F.S.O.L, Orbital, The Orb, stuff like that before getting into psytrance. Bugi has a B.A from the Music Academy and played flute and piano etc. with famous Macedonian musicians. He is the real genius.

So I guess when we synergised all our experiences it had to come out with something close to your description.

Your last album 'Sine Qua Non' has

some great psychedelic and groovey tracks on it. How long did it take to write and what most inspired it?

Thanks. We put a lot of work into the second album, it took three to four years to collect all the material for it. Many things inspire us, sometimes we play a lot of the old school stuff, especially Flying Rhino and Dragonfly, sometimes parties and of course our spiritual lifes give us the most inspiration.

Take us through the production of one of your favourite tracks, the software used on it etc.?

We work using Logic and basically use Logic plug-ins. We love Korg's stuff and for the album used Korg MS2000B a lot; it has very nice filters and is great for live tweaking because most of the controls are easily accessible. We usually record around one to three hours material for every track most of it live tweaking and then we boil that down to nine minutes. Ahhh, and of course we change the bass



line around 10 times for each track.

Tell us more about the Macedonian psytrance scene, parties etc. With both yourselves and Atriohm making Forest music and Distorted Goblin dark psy, why does this style dominate in your country do you think? The scene had great beginnings around 1996-7 with the help of Daniel aka Bushava Azbuka. The vibe at parties was amazing with lots of big names like Etnica, James Monroe, Tsuyoshi Susuki playing, but after 2001-2 with some not so great parties it dropped a bit. The small more private parties kept the flame alive. Again around 2004-5 it revived with a great small festival near the capital Skopje and since then more and more new artists have come into the scene. Forest style dominanting has of course something to do with the nature around us, when you come and visit us you'll definitely got the idea.

Apparently there are two of you in Sonic Wave Control, tell us about your separate histories?

Jay: I started DJing in 1998 as Jay OM, producing as Journey and Star~Trip (a collaboration with Anton Petrov) in 2003, Omsphere in 2009 and Crocodile Rangers (with Braincell) in 2011.

Steve: I started back in 1991 and over the years I've had some big hitters like Steve Morley 'Reincarnations', Dave Holmes 'Samsara' and Starchild's 'Redemption'. I still love every moment in the industry.

How did the two of you get together, who does what in the studio?

Jay: We signed Steve and Jess (Cathar) to Free-Spirit Records in 2011 and that is how we met. After I finished my second Journey album I had a chance to work in the studio with Steve and we found it a lot of fun, very creative with some great results. We

each lead on some things and follow on others.

Steve: Jessica (my fiancée) and I do Cathar together and after sending our tracks to Free-Spirit Records, Jay decided to sign us. Since then we have become good friends sharing a similar taste and outlook on music. We both have an equal input in the studio.

How would you describe your sound for those who haven't heard it? Tribal, Progressive, Psychedelic, Trance

As your debut album, how long did it take to write and is it virtually the first thing you've released?

Jay: It all happened very fast. We hooked up once in my studio and ended up having a track done in one session, so we decided to write a couple more and release an EP. But the tracks just kept coming and we ended up writing

the whole album in two months – sometimes good things happen quickly! After that I did the mastering and the graphics and the album was ready to be released. We are still surprised at how fast and smooth the whole process was.

Anything you'd like to say to Revolve's readers, about future plans?

Jay: On the S.W.C side we are planning to get our music out there as much as we can and are looking forward to get back in the studio to start working on the next album... we have so many ideas.

On the Free-Spirit side there is plenty coming up; Holographic Brain, Hypnocoustics and Moka Mafia EPs, Cosmic Warrior, Techyon and Twelve Sessions albums with many more surprises on the horizon.

Doctor Spook celebrates the 11th year of his label group and 'Revolve' steps forward to open the bubbly and find out more

Your label family has been going for a long time now, what are the different labels within the group

Morningstar (Melodic Psytrance/ Full on / Progressive) and Darkstar (hard, heavy, night psy) were launched in 2006. Geo-Israel and Geo-Mexico began in 2007 for music from these areas. Bass Star (Breaks / Chill / Dubstep) and Goa Records (multigenre-Psy) were founded in 2008. In 2009 Power House Rec (Techno / Progressive / Electro) and Digital Drugs Coalition (night psy / fullon) were established. Ovnimoon Records started in 2010 (Goa / Psy / Progressive / Chill). In 2011 we started Dubstep SF (Dubstep / Electro / Drumstep). This year Fresh Frequencies joins our team.

With illegal file-sharing sites, how do you make running a label work?

Growing any company is much like life. As new opportunities are created, it's our responsibility here on the "crest-ofthe-wave" with art, humanity and technology all converging, to embrace these tools to reach new fans. I discovered Goa Trance in 1996 through a sharing service called Audio Galaxy, without it I might not have been inspired to found Geomagnetic. When the seed is planted, flowers grow!

How do you remain so positive, what's the secret?

As a youth growing up in San Francisco in the 80s, the Psychedelic foundation of the land no doubt had an impact. My whole family is very positive so I would say that upbringing has a lot to do with one's demeanour. Following Your Bliss seems key. True success is doing something you have passion for. Otherwise one's subconscious will subvert your energy towards your real desire. So why not combine the two?

Tell us a little about your own project?
Mind Storm music and visuals project continues to trance-form. Next is an





immersive interactive audio / visual environment, both an installation and touring stage-show integrating hi-def real time 3D-animated sound sensitive (midi, multi-octave, speech) custom mapped imagery. Kinetix 3D cameras allow live motion capture... really exciting!

If there is to be a consciousness change, how do you see it impacting what you do?

It's not IF, it's when. Consciousness is evolving! People are finally waking up! It's not too late! However there is major global danger that is being veiled from the general public. The .001% are waging nuclear war against all life on earth. The repercussions of the global powers causing Japanese reactors to melt down through combined design and apparent "negligence", thus spreading the planet's worst catastrophe in known history is something to damaging to ignore. Our one hope will be if everyone on earth becomes aware of the situaand devotes ALL RESOURCES together to solve this calamity. There is STILL HOPE!

So John you've been around for a while now, tell us how you got into DJing and what you remember of those early acid house days?

Yes, been DJing now 25 years! The headmaster actually got me my first gig while at school when I was 15, he was putting on a school 'disco' for the school kids... where I actually played more specialist electronic music. The acid days were phenomenal, I've never ever experienced such wonderful days since.

When did you come across psytrance music, who were the biggest influences for you then and now?

with Russell Coultart, the owner of Transient records. Russell introduced me to the likes of Juno Reactor and Astral Projection in 1991/92 and from that day on I was hooked. Some of today's Psy clubbers presume I'm making a switch from club Trance to Psy

Trance, if they did their homework they'll see I've been actively involved in it since its birth.

Many people might not have heard of Joof Recordings. How did the label come about, what sort of music do you release and what's important to know about the label?

JOOF was an offshoot of Transient records, born in 1998 with my partner Russell Coultart. The Psy Trance scene often completely overlooks the fact that there is a healthy underground scene in the regular Trance world. Unfortunately the commercial 'super stars' have bastardised Trance's once great name.

Over the past decade I'm seeing these two worlds moving closer together, hence why we often have releases from familiar names such as; Vibrasphere, Tegma, E-Clip, Human Blue, Micky Noise, Freq, Ace Ventura and Astral Projection to name a few.

You'll be representing 15 artists with the new booking agency, can you tell us about some who might not be so well known to the psytrance scene?

Along with all the names I've already mentioned, if you love serious deep, dark hypnotic Trance, then you need to check out Oliver Prime. He's such a talent. Also Moscow's Anton Chernikov has a kind of 'lboga' sound, he's actually just done a number of remixes for Iboga. Cosmithex, Magnus and Dejavoo are also names to watch out for.

Who should people contact for bookings and anything else you'd like to say? Another Transient records connection, Kristian (from Dejavoo) from the older days. Kristian lives and breathes the Psy scene, he has such a passion for this wonderful world. He was a natural choice to get behind the reins to run our DJ and live agency. We have one of the

oa seems to be back as a great place to party if this year's season is anything to judge by. I didn't get there until March, but with the emergence of a new wealthy Indian middle-class looking for thrills and spills to spend their money on, the scene now lasts from October until May. There's a big increase in international visitors from everywhere and still in April four planes worth of Russians weekly coming in for fun in the sun. With temperatures in March / April apparently still at minus 20 degrees in Moscow I reckon it's a pretty easy choice as to where to be. There also seemed to be far less muscled guys in sportswear around and more of a hippy 'family' feel to the Russian crowd.

With big parties such as that at Blue Waves for Boom with 2,000 people crammed into every space and packed parties around New Year when prices go crazy, plus the usual scene influx in mid January, February and March when it's not ridiculously busy, the hippy, trippy Bermuda triangle is very much alive and pulsing with energy

For myself and anyone getting there at the end of February, Goa took a while to get going. Then national elections were taking place, meaning the imposition of a ban on the sale of alcohol after 10pm or throughout election days, which generally means no parties.

There were a couple of word-of-mouth parties at the new Our Shack Bar on Little Vagator, Spaghetti Beach run by Isaiah, which has serious potential for next year. But no alcohol sales mean no money to pay the Police, so that parties can carry on into the night. Chapora was deserted and after 10pm. there were many people driving around looking for something to do. By the time of the first big party after the elections, people were ready to explode. A great line-up which saw Aphid Moon and then Dickster raise the energy up to full power at Shiva Valley - always on the Tuesday night - was amazing and set the tone for the rest of the late season. UV Bar in Anjuna where I had the pleasure to play quite a few sets has really developed now and had parties on all the time, many of them going right


through to the next morning, which was almost unheard of just two years ago. Next to it a new venue Hippies, slotted in some memorable parties every now and then on the beach and Curlies with its Thursday night party has got more and more popular with the Indian crowd in particular. Hilltop in Vagator even though it finishes early cleaned up with a great Parvati night on its regular Sunday night slot. 9Bar came back into its own towards the end of the season and there was an especially good party for the owner's birthday at West End Club in Siolim which always goes on through the night.

Add to that Anjuna's famous flea market, great beaches, cheap food and beer and you can see why Goa once again is brimming with potential. A home away from home for some, especially my good Russian friends with Germans, Italians, Israelis, Iranians and even a Welshman adding to the international flavour.

Democracy 2.0: Icelandic style

In Iceland, the people have made the government resign, the primary banks have been nationalised and it was decided not to pay the debt that these banks created with Great Britain and Holland due to their bad financial policies. Perhaps more importantly, a public assembly has been created to rewrite the constitution and all of this has been done in a peaceful way.

A whole revolution against the powersthat-be who have created the current crisis. This is why there hasn't been any publicity during the last two years about what has happened in Iceland. What would happen if the rest of the EU citizens took this as an example? What would happen if US or UK or Greek citizens took this as an example? This is a summary of the facts.

In 2008, the main bank of the country was nationalised. The Krona, the currency of Iceland devalued and the stock market stopped with the country bankrupt. Citizens protested in front of parliament and eventually managed to get new elections that led to the resignation of the prime minister and his

whole government. The country was in a bad economic situation. A law proposed paying back the debt to Great



Britain and Holland through the payment of 3,500 million euros, to be paid by the people of Iceland monthly for the next 15 years at a 5.5% interest rate.

But in 2010, the people took to the streets and demanded a referendum. In January 2010 the president announced a popular meeting. In March, a referendum and the denial of payment of bad debts was voted in by 93%. Meanwhile the government initiated an investigation

to bring to justice those responsible for the crisis, and many high-level executives and bankers were arrested. All the implicated parties were made to leave the country. A new assembly was then elected to write a new Constitution which would include the lessons learned from this, and substitutes the current one (a copy of the Danish Constitution). 25 citizens have been chosen, with no political affiliation out of the 522 candidates. To be a candidate you simply needed to be an adult with the support of 30 people. The constitutional assembly started in February of 2011 to present the 'Carta Magna' from the recommendations given by different assemblies happening throughout the country. It must be approved by the current Parliament and by the one constituted through the next legislative elections. So to summarise the Icelandic revolution:

- resignation of the whole government
- nationalisation of the bank-referendum so the people can decide over the economic decisions
- incarcerating the responsible parties
- the people.rewriting the constitution. How about it happening everywhere!

Grow your own shrooms

p until 2005, in the UK, it was possible to buy magic mush-rooms legally and of course, I occasionally partook and always had a fabulous time. It was only when the Drugs Act 2005 came into force that I seriously began to miss our little fungal friends.

It was not long, before companies began to fill the gap by offering first spores and then idiot-proof growkits and as soon as I got my hands on the latter, the childhood memories of growing one's own vegetables rapidly returned. Wholecelium.com (previously known to many as Mush-e-mart) is one of the companies that delivers quality growkits via courier all over Europe. Legally it's a grey area, so we won't go there in this article. Read the website's T&C's for your legal rights.

This article is just to explain how easy – and how FUN – the process is. For a little over 30 Euros you will have, in a few days, a growkit. You can follow the instructions on http://bit.ly/L48iMq but the most important thing to remember is to keep your hands and all surfaces completely clean at all moments.

The substrate (and especially the

polythene growbag) can easily become contaminated by flora on your hands. The other thing to remember is when to harvest your first crop: wait until their little hats begin to open. A quick search on YouTube will also provide you with many helpful instructions. I always go for the Mexican mushrooms (Psilocybe Cubensis) because you get a good combination of giggles and visuals.

You may wish to make a spore-print of your first mushroom. I did this and am saving it for later use. Again, full instructions can be found on the net and in particular on the excellent web-

Site www.shroomery.org

Growing from a spore print involves a lot more dedication and equipment, but if you are on a budget then you will end up getting a lot more value out of your initial purchase.

I normally get four flushes from each kit, the first being the most impressive.



Once you've removed the first mush-rooms, start the process again. Instructions on

drying are on the Shroomery website. Obviously, if you are eating straight away this will be unnecessary, but I dried mine on a couple of sheets of newspaper, turning every day, with small packets of silica gel between each mushroom (but not touching – see



photo). You can buy these on eBay very cheaply. The best results were when I left a small fan blowing on them during three days. After that period, they were as dry as a cracker. Once dry, keep them in a sealed and darkened place for consumption later.

As for the results... well, just three of those big mushrooms was enough for me to have a full-on, highly visual experience lasting three hours, a far more visual experience than a lot of LSD I have enjoyed in recent years.

Put the fun into fun-gi and start growing these babies now. You won't regret it. THE TRIPTON FACTOR

Be healthy: avoid aspartame

f you didn't need more proof that some major brands are not safe to put into your body then check out the record of artificial sweetener aspartame, which has just had a name change to Aminosweet. This is an everyday component of most diet drinks, flavoured waters, chewing gum or artificial sweeteners like NutraSweet® or Canderel®. Yet there is evidence showing that it can cause depression, headaches, dizziness, chronic fatique syndrome, memory loss and weight gain, just some of the reactions reported by people to the US Food and Drug Administration (FDA). It is the cause of almost 75% of complaints to the FDA, yet is still sold. Dr John W. Olney of the Washington University Medical School in St. Louis has even published research showing a high incidence of brain tumours in aspartame-fed rats.

Invented as a drug in 1965, it was only when a chemist mixed aspartic acid and phenylalanine, two naturally-occurring amino acids and found they produced a sweet taste that the patent to the FDA was changed and aspartame was allowed to be added to various products.

When you look into these two amino acids then you can see quite easily how this compound can cause humans problems when ingested.

Aspartic acid (40% of aspartame) is a neurotransmitter that is fine in small doses but too much in the brain kills neural cells by allowing too much calcium into the cells. In high concentrations, 75% percent of neural cells in a particular area of the brain are killed off before any clinical symptoms would be shown.

Phenylalanine (50% of aspartame) when it builds up in the brain can cause the levels of serotonin in the brain to decrease, leading to emotional disorders such as depression. It has been proven that users of aspartame have excessive levels of the amino acid in their brain.

The other 10% is methanol. The US environmental protection agency (EPA) considers that methanol is a cumulative poison and recommends just 7.8mg/day. One litre of an aspartame-sweetened diet drink per day and you'll be taking in 56mg of 'poison'. Symptoms from methanol poisoning include headaches, ear buzzing, dizziness, nausea, and gastrointestinal disturbances



And a 2005 study by the University of Texas Health Science Centre in San Antonio showed that increased use of diet drinks in a population-based study made people more susceptible to obesity. Animal studies show that a sweet taste produces insulin to be released which causes blood sugar to be stored in tissues including fat. But the diet drinks don't actually increase blood sugar so people become hypoglaecemic, therefore eating more food the next time they eat to replace the lost blood sugars.

Approved by the FDA in 1974, aspartame shows how easily pharmaceutical companies can introduce cheap additives to foodstuffs that can make us ill.

So, just make sure aspartame is not on your shopping list.

Take care, look into what you wear

Textile-making is not only one of the most polluting industries in the world, but the poisonous residues from pesticides kill tens of thousands in the developing world every year.

Conventional cotton farming uses approximately 25% of the world's insecticides and more than 10% of the pesticides (including herbicides, insecticides and defoliants).

- According to the World Health Organisation, 20,000 individuals die of cancer and miscarriages each year in developing countries as a result of the chemicals sprayed on conventional cotton. Overexposed to pesticides, farm workers suffer with asthma, neurological damage and cancer.
- The US Environmental Protection Agency categorises seven of the 15 most common pesticides used on cotton in the year 2000 in the US as "possible," "likely," "probable," or "known" human carcinogens (Acephate, 1,3-Dichloropropene, Diuron, Fluometuron, Pendimethalin, Tribufos, and Trifluralin).
- In 2003, 55 million lbs of Pesticides were sprayed on the 12.8 million acres of conventional cotton

grown in the United States (4.30 lbs per acre), making cotton the third most heavily treated US crop behind corn and soybeans.

• In 2000, more than 2 billion lbs of Synthetic fertilisers were applied to cotton crops worldwide. That's nearly 150 lbs of chemicals per acre. The cotton for one t-shirt uses a 1/3 lb of chemicals.

At least 17,368 Indian farmers killed themselves in 2009.

There have been claims of genetically-modified (GM) seeds (such as Bt cotton) being responsible for the farmer suicides. A US television documentary by Frontline found that farmers using more expensive GM seeds promoted by Cargill and Monsanto have got into debt, forcing some into the equivalent of indentured servitude to moneylenders.

Toxic dyes or other chemical finishes also cause a wide variety of health problems for us. Chemically sensitive people suffer from skin rashes, fatigue, muscle and joint pain. Symptoms in children include red cheeks and ears, hyperactivity and behaviour or learning problems.

Dyes and dye fixatives used to bond the dye colour to the fabric often contain

toxic metals and chemicals which cause

- health problems. These include:

 Dioxin a carcinogen and possible hormone disrupter;
- Toxic heavy metals such as zinc, chrome, copper known carcinogens;
- Formaldehyde a suspected carcinogen.

Because clothing comes into prolonged contact with your skin, toxic chemicals are absorbed through it, especially when you sweat. Once absorbed, heavy metals accumulate in the liver, kidney, bones, heart and brain. The effects on health can be significant when high levels accumulate, especially in children due to effects on growth and their relatively low body mass.

Toxic chemicals from dyes also create severe environmental havoc. Most garments are produced in developing countries where pollution controls are often lax or nonexistent, so discharges from huge numbers of the textile producers go straight into rivers where the river water might be bright green one day and yellow the next.

For all these reasons, it is time to be conscious about what you eat and also what you or your children wear!

ajja – '*Tulpa*' (peak Records)

The mercurial psychedelic tattoo that is Ajja quantumally reduces all of his divergent psychological

depths and life experiences onto his second album. Tulpa is a Tibetan term encompassing the idea of making an idea concrete, visualising it through discipline, a perfect summation of the many many hours spent in the studio on each track – something downloaders take all for granted.

He's carefully made the crazy depths of dark psychedelic sound more accessible with tunes from 144 to 148bpm only, lending them a groove and purpose that others often forsake. Check first track 'Bebopper' full of layers resonating with little squiggles and the slightly harder second track 'Rude Alert.' Bazinga', 'Surge' and 'Ifriend' developthe enveloping depths of sounds that surround and befriend you.

These start to become melodic and morning-sound friendly with 'Sidewinder' and its crystalline sound echoing even more expressively.

But then there is a return to twilight with 'Widdershins' which initially sounds like being stuck in a dripping stalactite-enthused cave with machine elves. The album finishes with the groovy, jazz-like sonic workout of 'three dots'.

A really interesting examination of the processes going on in Ajja's mind, sound construction and accesing of what psychedelic sound is all about. Beautiful artwork by Filip Leu and Tanina, this is the complete package. Buy it to truly value!

Various artists - '*Resistrance*' (Hadra)

Complied by Hadra head honcho DJ Driss this is a two CD comp. starting as it means to go on with a great opening track by Rinkadink 'Ab Zee' with a slightly glitchy feel to it. Next favourite Broken Toy's 'Scary Spirits,' its production quality excellent and with a different feel to the other tracks on CD1.

CD2 starts with Curious Detail's 'Yellow eye', full on with very good use of key changes on the bassline making my head bob back and forth like a pigeon you know when they try to walk really fast LOL. The next track I'm giving a big thumbs up to is Digital Talk and Geko's 'Direct controf. Simply banging' with excellent use of bassline breakdowns.

Well this is a very unique album, very special in many ways, I must admit brave as well in these hard times for the scene. The album is a true work of art, showing how sometimes artists should have balls and make music as an artform rather then just as dancefloor bombs. This album is full of different elements, ideas, atmosphere, fxs but also arrangement-wise there's a lot of diversity. I am a big fan of a square wave so hearing it in a few tracks on this album produced and used well was a pleasant surprise. The production is tight, the mix is good and again diverse. All in all it's a very spacey, deep, psychedelic album, and can be seen as something more than just party music.

after was a bit off the story, but for sure people will dig it. 'Everything remains' which follows gives the album a necessary lift up and then 'Infinity remix' takes you to a new dimension. It's more bright and clear sounding, something for the beginning of the morning on the dancefloor. 'Another world is a more dirty, acidic style of psytrance again something that reminds me of old 3D Vision, Absolum, CPU that type of sound, 'Mental Universe' and 'Ascention' just keep the overall groove going in the mid part of the album and 'Pandora' my favourite track together with 'Algarythm' slowly, smoothly closes this psychedelic, dancefloor mover of an album.

Well produced, although occasionally bordering on predictable for those synchronised 'hands in the air' moments, there's just enough peripheral tweakage to keep it interesting. Top tunage

comes in the form of subtly shifting smooth building groovy 140 bpm nudger 'All seeing Eye', the cheeky driving 'Intergalactic', previously released 'Another Planet' and last track 'Fly thru the universe' although DJs should beware of the unexpected speeded-up kick at the end if they don't want to look like a complete tit.

Four winning compilations later, their fifth album sees the label taking its first step into artist releases. Dust is a fine place to start, as Florence-based artist Andrea Lunghi has been responsible for many of the compilation highlights either solo or as collaborator, displaying a level of musicianship and production artistry that makes his debut album a must-have. Bpms orbit around 145, with crisp, twisted synth work and clean burbling atmospherics providing the wrongness. Favourites include 'Go Nuts, Please' whose funky rhythms and rock 'n' roll attitude are sure to get the room bouncing, while 'Blast Chance' offers shades of Peak Records twisted synth noodling breaking down into downright filthy distorted wobbage.

Consistently musical, inventive and balanced tunes with groove and wollop. Android Jones completes the package with stunning artwork.

SONIC SPECIES – 'UNLEASH THE BEAT' (ALCHEMY RECORDS)

'Unleash The Beat is the eagerly awaited debut album from Sonic Species which glides around from 138bpm to



143bpm. The album kicks off with 'The First and the Last' with its distorted lead line which really hooks you in. The second track 'Techno

Systems' pumps along very nicely getting the adrenalin going. The album also features collaborations with other artists, the first of which is with Zen Mechanics and is called 'Spice Travel'. With a deep pumping bass this track chugs along really nicely. The second collaboration is with Avalon named 'Back to Reality' which has powerful melodic Goa melodies to compliment the pumping bass. The last collaboration is with Mr Peculiar called 'Unleash the beat' which is a more uplifting atmospheric number.

All in all this album is a good uplifting morning offering that will not disappoint.

various **APTISTS** *FeeLings*' (ovnimoon Records)

Released earlier this year Hector Stuardo (Ovnimoon) brings us a lovely collection

which could be described as emotional deep progressive trance.

Anyone who is a fan of the likes of Zvce or Flegma and Nerso will love this album, bouncy beats and blissful breaks giving you an uncontrollable urge to dance.

It starts with a mellow number from Psychophysical Transcripts that's really lush, then on to rolling basslines with dreamy leads and pads from Solar Spectrum ('Static' & 'Mini Big') both leaving you with the feeling of wanting to hear more. Monolock's 'Once upon a time' I found somewhat cheesy in the breakdown but still remains a good track.

Other tracks of note are Ovnimoon & Elergy's 'I am you' which packs a punch to give a very tribal edge, Lyctum's 'Open the Gate' is excellent too, a chunky bassline and deep swirling leads throughout but the best track is certainly by Liquid Sound, 'In Motion to the Ocean', which is an absolute stomper even if it has an over used film sample.

All in all, an excellent offering from Ovnimoon Records and without a doubt one to look out for

A respectable compilation from Ovnimoon compiled by Pick (George Khanukaev) a young man from Israel. Groovy, squelchy, bassy, and interesting sound designs as we would expect from the featured artists here Pspiralife. Merkaba and Dharana, the Zenon Records noble producers keep it real of course. Muggi Dane (Moses) starts things off with a minimal-tech track, 'Neutronium' a stylish deep minimal tribalistic track well worth having in your collection for those mysterious sexy times when a bit of class is called for. Pick remixed a Dharana track, this is a personal favourite the bent jazzyness of Martini Bitch is imaginative and bizarre, exactly why it tickles my fancy. It has a clever voice sample intro and galloping rhythm throughout. There is a perfect blend of dark deep lower frequencies and wacky jazz patches structured in an interesting and experimental way that those in an eccentric mood will be sure to appreciate. Vaeya takes us on guite a beautiful journey with Quantiza, the track is perfect in experimental style, though I feel there is an overpowering siren sound half way through that taints it. Bruio's Bowl has produced an inspiring one here with '2 Step to Drop' (I would expect nothing less from this talented box of tricks!) As usual from Bruio's Bowl we have interesting percussion, fat bass, and most importantly that thing we call groove. Perfect for those moments in the chill-out when we want to up the tempo and inject some groove and proggy vibes to ruffle some movers inna sub bass whomp-dom. This release features a very nice dark minimal track from Radioactive.Cake. You're twistin' my whompdom man

Miss Piskev (Funtazula Records)

Various artists - 'LBW (LOW Bass WITHIN)' (ZENON RECORDS)

The latest from Zenon, the label so prolific inspirational that the term "Zenonesque" has become widely used to describe the style they have nurtured. Compiled by label founder Sensient, this release sees a return to the dark minimal sounds they are best known for. Each track has its own story to tell, always surprising, psychedelic and powerful, this compilation proves that there is no stopping the ever expanding Zenon roster from delivering constantly evolving, ground-breaking music. Stand-out tracks include: Hellquist's



'Qvantakse' for its dark driving groove. The consistently brilliant Pspiralife hits us with another dose of dripping synths and immersive sound effects. The experimental jazz fuelled trip through the imagination of Pick, followed by Disfunction, taking us deeper into the uncharted Zenon jungle with 'Magical Mantra'. If you like the sound of experimental-tribal-minimal-psy-progtech-step and you're not following Zenon's every release, then sit up and pay attention. These guys mean business!

HYPOGEO - 'TREE OF LIES' (ZENON Decopos)

Italian Nicola Grigatti's début dark progressive album as Hypogeo is truly astounding. It is a powerful, well executed album that reflects his influences of Death Metal and Industrial, acts such as Ministry and Skinny Puppy to name but a fraction. At times this album really reminds me of X-Dream/The Delta, whom I've always enjoyed.

I must say that this truly is the darkest dance album I've ever listened to, to the point of it being slightly disturbing but its amazing! Excellent chunky beats, spiralling sounds and deep leads that give

a feeling of depth as well as space. I love the opening track, Micro/Drama, it's like a dark version of Garry Anderson's UFO soundtrack while 'Walking on a Frozen lake' has a way of making you feel like you're falling into the abyss. 'Lamb of Dog' is excellent, with its twists and turns. Following that there's a remix of Sensient's 'Cluster Fuck' that only has a fraction of the original but just as good.

I also really enjoyed 'Trip to Ixtlan' ... chunky with lots of squelch. Confusingly the last track is 'Macro\Drama'...but once you squint you get the point...

In conclusion, it's certainly an album to have, certainly an act to follow and a highlight at Cosmo Festival that I am really looking forward to.

of good red wine. I don't deny that I've always loved the duo's



Heal, grow, get back into life's flow By Rebecca Young



In essence, healing is about identifying and activating that which is life supporting and life enhancing, and undoing that which is not. I am talking about that which supports and enhances the life of the spirit, which could also be called 'the truth of who you are', not to be confused with any particular physical form or 'outcome'. The life of the spirit is beyond form, but can give rise to forms that are in accordance with it. These tend to be the circumstances and manifestations that we feel happy with in our everyday lives.

No matter someone's outer circumstances, there is always a distinct difference between their energies, patterns and behaviours that are life supporting or enhancing and those which are not.

I'd like to see humanity freed from all life-limiting structures and perspectives. And it's going to require a lot of people working with life and being willing to access the underlying wisdom, in order to get us to that point. When we do this work, it paves the way for the creation of a new world, a new experience of what it is and what it means to be alive and human. At every level, it requires us to evolve (upgrade) our inner and outer structures and systems into ones that value a kind of care and connection that recognises and supports the life of the spirit, and the associated creative flourishing of individuals and groups. At the collective level, it requires us to evolve our social and societal structures and our cultural systems in accordance with those values.

However, creating the new is not always as rapid (or comfortable) as letting go the old, because it can take trial and error to work out exactly what 'new' is needed. It may take time and experimentation to clarify and develop a new structure (hone and tweak the foundational wave form) that works well to build towards what you want to create. It is a truly co-creative process between all the personality (or collective societal) experiences you have had and grown through, and all the deeper, who-youare wisdom you can access (whether individually or collectively), to build your system-viable 'new' self. And that's why the path of the spiritual evolutionary. likewise the activist. likewise the artist. requires dedication.

The underlying wisdom is always operating within each one of us, available at any moment to contribute to heal and evolve our consciousness and our individual and collective creations. I help people access that wisdom and

thereby heal and grow through accessing their own unique answers. I teach tools and step-wise processes that people can learn to access that wisdom, which empowers them to recognise and release blocks for themselves, and become masters of their own life's evolution.



Going Ape For The Orang-utans!

very minute an area equal to six football fields of Indonesian forest disappears forever. Minute by minute trees are falling into the abyss of no return and with it the orangutans whose lives depend on the forest for food and shelter. The Sumatran orangutan is critically endangered. Habitat loss and poaching are pushing them towards extinction as you read this article. Hour by hour, people's use of palm oil means the remaining habitats of the Orangutans are being destroyed. Forest destruction for palm oil plantations is business and as any unsustainable business it's driven by profit regardless of the consequences.

The word orangutan comes from the Malay language meaning "Man of the forest". Orangutans belong to the great apes and are our closest living relatives on Earth. We are from the same family. they are our cousins and that's why we have so much in common. Today there are only four species of our cousins alive on Earth: chimpanzees, bonobo, gorillas and orangutans - all at risk of extinction. Apes are a crucial part of rainforest health as they spread seeds and ensure the biodiversity of the forests remains intact. This has consequences on many other species that depend on the forests including humans.

In Sumatra there are only 6,600 orangutans left in the wild. The Tripa

swamp is the most densely concentrated inhabitated area and key for the species survival. Less than 25% is left of the peat forests: 75% is covered with palm-oil plantations already.

Sumatra's largest palm oil company PT Kallista Alam has started illegal fires across Sumatra's largest refuge of the great apes. A court case against PT Kallista Alam ruled in their favour and in addition to hundreds of orangutans who have died in the fires it will claim more casualties as these peaceful apes' home is raped by human greed.

"The speed of destruction has gone up dramatically in the last few weeks... This is obviously a deliberate drive by these companies to clear all the remaining forests," Dr Singleton, conservation director of the Sumatran Orangutan Conservation Programme, said in 'The Independent'.

"If this is not stopped right now, all those orang-utans... will be gone before the end of 2012."

What can you do about this? There are many things that you can do:

- Go ape and stop buying products containing palm oil;
- 2. Go ape and ask corporations to take corporate responsibility and source sustainable palm oil;
- Go ape and take caution: Some products may not mention palm oil and instead may refer to vegetable oil;



- 4. Go ape, don't buy furniture and things made out of tropical wood and buy sustainable-farmed wood;
- Go ape and watch Green www.greenthefilm.com
- 6. Go ape and view a list of brands and corporations using palm oil at www.whaleofatime.org/green.php


